LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT:

ANNUAL HEALTH DEPT. REPORT:

Mr. Laws Rushing presented the court with the annual report of Health Dept. which is included in the folder with the rest of the minutes. Comm. Earl Wright made the motion to accept the report and Comm. Charles Culver seconded. After a show of hands vote, motion carried. 151

DEBT SERVICE FUND:

Comm. James Westbrock explaines to the court that since we have a greater fund balance in the Debt Service Fund, when these funds are borrowed for buses, it is costing us more interest than we can get by investing it, I would suggest that we amend the Debt Service Fund in the amount of \$48,000.00 to pay sthe Capital Outlay Note instead of paying any interest and then turning around and paying it off. He puts this in a form of a motion and Comm. Joe White seconded it. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Comm. Chærles Culver and seconded by Comm. Ronnie Bates. After a show of hands vote, meeting adjourned till January term of Court.
