

COUNTY COURT MEETING APRIL 15, 1985

On April 15, 1985, the county Commissioners met in regular session. Co. Executive H. C. Brundige called the court to order and County Clerk Faye Butts had roll call with all commissioners present. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court and Comm. Lewis Garner had invocation.

Approval of minutes of Regular Meeting 1-21-85 and Special meeting of 3-15-85. Motion to accept the minutes made by Comm. Wm. Mansfield and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEES REPORT: Motion to accept the trustees report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Bobby Parker. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT:

Motion to accept the General Fund report made by Comm. V. J. Shanklin and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT REPORT: Motion to accept the highway dept. report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and Seconded by Comm. Wm. Mansfield. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

DEPT OF EDUCATION REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Lewis Garner and seconded by Comm. Larry Jolley. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Gerald Caldwell told the Commissioners the only business they had was the transfers from the sheriffs dept. Motion to accept this was made by Comm. Bobby Parker and seconded by Comm. Ronnie Bates. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright told the Comm. of an increase in rates by \$5.00 which will be brought up in a resolution later in the meeting.

HEW COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Johnny Vincent said the Committee met and issued a permit to Hal Jergenon, who is currently running the rural garbage route, for Co. Household Waste Garbage and that was all. Motion to accept this was made by Comm. Larry Jolley and seconded by Comm. Sam Sinclair. After a show of hands vote, motion accepted. Secondly, we met with the Chamber of Commerce to help recruit industry. As a Committee we recommend to the full commission that a 5 man committee be appointed to work with the Chamber of Commerce in securing industry for our County. Their job will be meeting with prospective industry and with the Chamber for some type of recommendation to bring back to the court. The 5 members we recommend are Comm. Jolley, Comm. Jimmy Brasfield, Comm. Bobby Parker, Comm. Earl Wright and Comm. Jimmy Westbrook, and the Committee will be call the Chamber of Commerce Lazion Committee and that is recommended by the HEW Committee. Motion to accept this made by Comm. Larry Jolley and seconded by Comm. Chris Mathis. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: No report just ask to speak at the end of the meeting.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE REPORT: Lynda Shannon told the court thank you for establishing the committee and they looked forward to working with them.

HEALTH DEPT. REPORT: Motion made by Comm. Bobby Parker to accept this report and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE'S RELIEF OF DELINQUENT TAXES: Motion to accept Trustees Relief of Delinquent Taxes made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Gene Harris. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.
