

WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY  
REGULAR MEETING APRIL 17, 1989

The regular meeting of the Weakley County Court was held on April 17, 1989 at 9:30a.m. in the County Courtroom of the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order by County Executive Kerry Killebrew and invocation was given by Comm. Sam Sinclair. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened the court and County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 20 Commissioners present. Approval of minutes of the regular meeting of January 16, 1989 was made by Comm. James Harold Bell and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE'S REPORT: Motion to accept the trustees report was made by Comm. George Broussard and seconded by Comm. James Harold Bell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept the general fund report was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT REPORT: Motion to accept the highway dept. report was made by Comm. George Broussard and seconded by Comm. Jimmy Brasfield. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT REPORT: Motion to accept the school dept report was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Motion to accept the nursing home report was made by Comm. Lewis Garner and seconded by Comm. David McAlpin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright, chairman of the committee reported to the court that they had met with Jeff Washburn and had presented the budget with no increase visible. Motion to accept the report was made by Comm. Jimmy Brasfield and seconded by Comm. Gerald Caldwell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Sam Sinclair, chairman of the budget committee, and reported to the court that they had met and did Budget Transfers with resolution coming later in the meeting. NO VOTE.

HEW COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Johnny Vincent, chairman of the committee, reported to the court that they had met with GTE and South Central Bell to discuss the 911 numbers. They would like to go to another county to see how it works and how it is set up. The Committee would like the County Executive and others to go with them. They would also like the County Exec. to set up the times for them. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Ronnie Bates and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Vernon Dunn reported to the court that everything was going well with no problems in any dept. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Joe White and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.
