RESOLUTIONS


Resolution No. 2017-47: This resolution fixes the jailer's fee for Weakley County, Tennessee. Mayor Bynum explained that the state reimbursement rate for prisoners at the Weakley County Detention Center is \$39 per day per prisoner beginning July 1, 2017. Mayor Bynum went on to say that this resolution references two past resolutions by the county that fixed the jailer's fee amount at \$35. He explained that Resolution 2017-47 fixes the jailer's fee for Weakley County to be equivalent to the State reimbursement rate but with a minimum fixed rate of no less than thirty-nine dollars (\$39.00) per day per misdemeanor per twenty-four (24) hour period of confinement in the Weakley County Detention Center, regardless of whether the state lowers the reimbursement rate as they have done in the past.

Commissioner Hawks made the motion to approve Resolution No. 2017-47 and recommend it to the Finance, Ways, and Means Committee, and with a second by Commissioner Hudson the motion to approve passed unanimously.

OTHER BUSINESS

Having no other business, Commissioner Hawks made the motion to adjourn the meeting and with a second by Commissioner Pope, the meeting was adjourned at 4:48 p.m.
