

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-33

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MITIGATION PLAN FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AND THE INCORPORATED CITIES OF SHARON, DRESDEN, GLEASON, GREENFIELD, AND MARTIN

WHEREAS, Weakley County recognizes its responsibility to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from major disasters and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County Emergency Management is committed to saving lives, reducing injuries, and reducing financial losses due to natural or manmade events; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the Weakley County Mitigation Plan is to identify specific vulnerabilities, formulate a degree of risk, and develop strategies to lessen or eliminate hazardous outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Commission has determined that adoption of the Weakley County Mitigation Plan is in the best interest of Weakley County and benefits the general welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of January, 2020, that the Weakley County Mitigation Plan shall be adopted and shall be used in the event of a major disaster or other emergency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
