RESOLUTION

Resolution to Amend Anticipated Fund Availability and Appropriations of the General Fund for the Fiscal Year 1974-75 of Weakley County, Tennessee.

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has declared the North and North East portion of Weakley County a low income area. This area includes in general Civil District 17, 13, 1, 4, 5 and that portions of District 25, 24 and 6 North East of a line gling South West from the South West corner of District 4 to a point where Highway # 54 enters Henry County, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has provided funds for a public service employment grant to employ persons from that area who are not employed or are underemployed, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government will reimburse Weakley County, Tennessee, 100% for those positions filled from the low income area, provided Weakley County provides funds for these positions in the annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court that the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year 1974-75 is amended as follows:
