

RESOLUTION TO PLACE THE RESPONSIBILITY IN THE WEAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY FOR THE EMPLOYMENT AND DISMISSAL OF DEPUTY SHERIFFS WITHIN THE WEAKLEY COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court has entered into several agreements with the State of Tennessee and the Federal Government which resulted in funds being allocated for use in the Weakley County Sheriff Department and which placed certain record systems, officer training and funding requirements on the Sheriff's Department; and,

WHEREAS, the present procedure for the employment and dismissal of Deputy Sheriffs rests with the elected Sheriff; and,

WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriffs are now paid from a Quarterly Court appropriation in the County General Fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session, at its April, 1975 term, that:

Upon recommendations from the elected County Sheriff the final decision rests with the Weakley County Quarterly Court regarding Employment and Dismissal of All Deputy Sheriffs within the County Sheriff Department.

BE IT, FURTHER RESOLVED that the Quarterly Court responsibility in this Resolution be vested in the Law Enforcement Committee, contingent upon final action by the Weakley County Quarterly Court.
