

RESOLUTION OF THE QUARTERLY COUNTY COURT OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, DISSOLVE THE WEAKLEY COUNTY AMBULANCE AUTHORITY, CREATING AN AMBULANCE COMMITTEE AND APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE COURT .

WHEREAS, THIS Quarterly County Court created the Weakley County Ambulance Board at the July term of 1970; and,

WHEREAS, the name of the Weakley County Ambulance Board was changed to Weakley County Ambulance Authority in January of 1971; and,

WHEREAS, when standing committees of this Court were appointed, action pertaining to the Ambulance Authority was deferred until such time as the Court saw fit to reorganize this operation; and,

WHEREAS, there is much confusion among members of the Quarterly County Court and the Ambulance Authority as to it's duties, powers, and responsibilities; and,

WHEREAS, the authority for creating an ambulance authority and the delegation of contract powers to such a body without legislative approval is of questionable legality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of County, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Weakley County Ambulance Authority is hereby Dissolved.

SECTION 2. That there is created an ambulance committee of the Quarterly County Court to be composed of seven court members, one of each of the seven zones of the County.

SECTION 3. That the following members of the Court be appointed to serve until the next regular appointment of standing committees:

SECTION 4. That all obligations and rights now owed to and by the Weakley County Ambulance Authority pursuant to any legally binding contract shall be assumed by the county, it being the intentions of this resolutions to continue those contractual services now operated under the general control of the Weakley County Ambulance Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all orders or resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
