RESOLUTION BY THE QUARTERLY COURT OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
CONCERNING 201 PLANNING FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR THE CITY
CITY OF SHARON, RESOLUTION NO. 1975-4, JANUARY 13, 1975.

Whereas, the City of Sharon operates and maintains a Sewage Treatment Plant and, whereas, the Environmental Protection Agency and the Tennessee Department of Public Health no longer consider the present system of wastewater treatment to be adequate to prevent pollution of the streams under Public Law 92-500, and, whereas, the City of Sharon is required to enter into a detailed study of the wastewater treatment facilities and, whereas, the Study area required by the Tennessee Department of Public Health extends beyond the corporate boundaries of the City of Sharon into the surrounding County.

Now, therefore, the Quarterly Court of Weakley County do hereby agree and urge the City of Sharon to proceed with the 201 Study for wastewater treatment facilities in the designated area and the County of Weakley does hereby request the City of Sharon to be the lead applicant for Federal Grant Funds for the purpose of making said Study with the understanding that no funds will be required for expenditure by Weakley County.
