

RESOLUTION NO. 1976-43:

This resolution was brought up in July term of Court and was moved to this October Court:

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING COUNTY OFFICIALS AND DEPARTMENT HEADS TO REVIEW OFFICE PERSONNEL AND PROCEDURES AND REQUEST THE STATE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE TO PREPARE AN EMPLOYEE'S HAND BOOK.

WHEREAS, the taxpayers and citizens of Weakley County are concerned about the increasing cost of county government; and,

WHEREAS, the increase in salaries and other operating expenses has greatly increased in the past few years; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that a number of the offices could operate efficiently with a reduction of personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, that each elected or appointed official and department head be requested to review the personnel and procedures of his or her office with the idea in mind of reducing personnel even if this means a reduction of services to the citizens of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Comptroller's office be requested to survey the offices and departments of Weakley County Government and make recommendations to the Quarterly Court as to any changes that could be made in increase efficiency in Weakley County Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Comptroller's office be requested to prepare an employee's handbook for Weakley County setting out job requirements, classifications, and benefits for Weakley County employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to all officials and department heads of Weakley County and to the Comptroller of the Treasury, State of Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all orders or resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
