

RESOLUTION # 1976-49:

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE L(&C/ &&
GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Juvenile Court has established a Juvenile Honor School for all minors who are determined to be delinquent from charges involving drugs and alcohol: and,

WHEREAS, this school was a pilot program to determine this effectiveness of treatment and education in an effort to reduce the use of drugs and alcohol by minors: and

WHEREAS, the Pilot School consisted of scheduled instruction two hours each week for eight weeks for the juveniles and their parents; and,

WHEREAS, this school was completed the 8th day of August 1976, and as of this date no minor who attended this school has been in Juvenile Court the second time; and,

WHEREAS, much interest has been shown from other Juvenile Courts, State Agencies and Federal Agencies concerning its success with the possibilities that the program might be adopted state wide; and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Juvenile Court desires to expend the school to include practically all areas where juveniles are found to be delinquent or in need of treatment; and,

WHEREAS, interest has been shown by the Tennessee Law Enforcement Planning Commission in this school to the level of possible grant funds being made available to purchase needed school equipment, supplies and instructors' compensation; and,

WHEREAS, when the 1976-77 General Fund Budget was adopted, sufficient funds were not included to expand the Juvenile Honor School.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session, this the 11th day of October, 1976, that the 1976-77 Weakley County General Fund Budget be amended as follows:
