

RESOLUTION 1977-27:

A Resolution to amend Resolution 1976-10, as amended, relative to the identification and classification of the public roads of Weakley County pursuant to provisions of Sections 54-903 and 54-904, Tennessee Code Annotated.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court by Resolution 1976-10 identified, and/or classified the public roads of this County as prescribed by the above named statutes, and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Highway Commission drafted a revised map on which all public roads subject to maintenance by the County were identified and classified in keeping with provisions of Sections 54-903, and 54-904, Tennessee Code Annotated, and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Highway Commission requested this Court to adopt the system recommended and to direct that expenditures for maintenance and construction be confined to the roads so identified, and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Highway Commission has requested this Court to add a fifth classification to the County Road System to provide and permit maintenance consisting of grader maintenance twice a year as to roads which provided the only access to property and roads without public access, as of the 1970 State Highway Map, upon request by the property owner to the commissioner from the district where the road is located.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session this 11th day of July, 1977, that:

1. The revised map is hereby declared to be the official draft reflecting five (5) classifications of the public roads of Weakley County to be maintained by the Weakley County Highway Department.
2. Maintenance and construction shall be restricted to roads reflected on the revised map.
3. Pursuant to provisions of Section 54-904, Tennessee Code Annotated all roads are hereby placed in one of the following classifications:
 1. Federal Secondary - hard surface with eighty (80) to one hundred (100) feet right-of-way.
 2. Roads with fifty (50) to eighty (80) feet right-of-way with chert or hard surface.
 3. Roads with fifty (50) feet right-of-way with a twenty (20) feet chert surface.
 4. Roads without established right-of-way with a rock travel surface of twenty (20) feet or less.
 5. Roads without public access and roads which provide for only access to property which do not meet the above classifications or standards, Maintenance shall be restricted to grader maintenance twice a year, and further restricted as to roads without public access, as shown on the 1970 State Highway Map. Requests for maintenance are to be made to the commissioner of the district in which the road is located.
4. The classifications of each road in the system shall be reflected on the approved map.
5. All subsequent proposals for addition to the herein designated system of roads must meet specifications of one of the above described classifications and be approved by the Weakley County Highway Commission before presentation to this Court for consideration.
6. Any and all previous action (s) of this Court determined to be in conflict with provisions of this Resolution are hereby rescinded.
