

RESOLUTION NO. 1977-28:

A Resolution to close and relocate the road known as the Sand Hill Church Road located in the 10th Civil District of Weakley County, Tennessee.

WHEREAS, K. T. Clay Company has requested that the Sand Hill Church Road be relocated to permit mining of the road now in existence, and,

WHEREAS, K. T. Clay Company has agreed to construct a new road upon its property and to dedicate the same upon acceptance by the Weakley County Highway Commission, which shall consist of basing with a 30 foot top and a 100 foot right-of-way. The materials for this section of black-top road shall be paid by K.T. Clay Company, with the remainder to be paid by the Weakley County Highway Department, and,

WHEREAS, said relocated, new road would provide means for better transportation than the existing road, and that the existing road shall not be closed and abandoned until the new road is accepted and ready for travel.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session this 11th day of July, 1977, that:

1. The existing Sand Hill Church Road located in the 10th Civil District of Weakley County, Tennessee, be relocated upon the property of K. T. Clay Company to consist of a basing of a 30 foot top and a 100 foot right-of-way, with the materials for this section of black-top road to be paid by K. T. Clay Company, and the remainder to be paid by the Weakley County Highway Department.

2. That upon the acceptance by the Weakley County Highway Commission of the new and relocated Sand Hill Church Road and the dedication of the same by K. T. Clay Company, the existing Sand Hill Church Road shall be abandoned to K. T. Clay Company,

3. Said new road shall become a part of the maintenance system of the Weakley County Highway Department.

TO: THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMISSION

The undersigned hereby petition the Weakley County Highway Commission and the County Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, to take such action as necessary to close a portion of road located in the 10th Civil District.

The section of road to be closed is located and described as follows:

beginning at the intersection of Merréll Finch Road and the Sand Hill Church Road on what is known as the Merréll Finch Extension, running west approximately one (1) mile to what is known as Sawyers Road or Jack Wilson Road.

The aforesaid road does not touch the lands of any person other than the undersigned and no other person uses the same and the closure of such road could not affect the right of interest or interest of any other person.

The Aforesaid section of road has not been used for sometime due to the condition of a bridge. The aforesaid section of road has not been maintained in approximately 20 years.
