

RESOLUTION NO. 1977-33:

A resolution To Amend The 1977-78 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget With Reference to Ambulance Service For Weakley County.

Whereas: Weakley County, at present, has a contract with Emergency Medical Service, Inc. to furnish emergency medical service for the residents of Weakley County, and:

Whereas; Weakley County now supplementsd Emergency Medical Service, Inc. in the Amount of \$61,000.00 annually, and:

Whereas: Weakley County Medical Service, Inc. has met with the Weakley County Quarterly Court Ambulance Committee and requested additional funds be made available for ambulance service, due to cost of living increases and inflation in general. This increase will allow the Emergency Medical Service, Inc. to continue serving the residents of Weakley County at its present level, and:

Whereas: When the 1977-78 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget was approved the anticipated excess fees from the County CourtClerk's Office was underestimated.

Now therefore Be It Resolved by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session this the 10th day of October, 1977, that the 1977-78 General Fund Budget be amended, effective October 1, 1977 as follows:

Revenue: Account #36731, Excess Fees Change to Read \$19,250.00  
(Increased \$8,250.00)

Disbursements: Account #44191.588 Ambulance Service Change to Read \$69,250.000  
(Increase \$8,250.00)
