

RESOLUTION NO. 1977-34:

RESOLUTION TO PLACE ALL COUNTY OFFICERS UNDER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 8-2204, TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED

WHEREAS, in order for Weakley County to retain qualified, diligent employees, it is necessary that those individuals that serve the public be adequately compensated; and,

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 8-2204 provides a means by which certain county officers may be placed on the maximum salary schedule; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Weakley County that this aforementioned means be used to provide compensation for these employees to insure that diligent, qualified individuals remain in the service of Weakley County and that qualified individuals be attracted to the service of Weakley County in the future; and,

WHEREAS, benefits will be derived to Weakley County in increased funds available for investment and increased tax effort for revenue sharing purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the many reports required by the State and Federal governments reporting wages, withholding taxes, social security, retirement, and insurance; and,

WHEREAS, more and more reports are required regarding employment of members of minority groups in order to receive funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session this 10th day of October, 1977 that pursuant to the provisions of Section 8-2204, Tennessee Code Annotated the following county officers of Weakley County are hereby placed on a maximum salary schedule as fixed by Section 8-2403, Tennessee Code Annotated:

1. County Court Clerk
2. Trustee
3. Circuit Court Clerk
4. Chancery Court Clerk and Master
5. Register of Deeds

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all fees and commissions collected by these officials shall be reported and paid to the county on a monthly basis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that salaries of deputies, clerks, and bookkeepers and extra shall be paid by county general fund warrant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
