

RESOLUTION NO. 1995 57
A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF A COUNTY FLAG
FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee will celebrate its Bicentennial in 1996 and has requested the submission of a county flag by each of the state's ninety-five counties; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has never adopted a county flag; and

WHEREAS, County Executive Ron Gifford has designed an appropriate flag for Weakley County, the design of which contains the Seal of Weakley County and elements intended to complement the state flag of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County, being one of the great counties of the State of Tennessee, is fully intending to recognize and celebrate two hundred years of statehood.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County, meeting in regular session on June 20, 1995, does adopt said county flag.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Weakley County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the county flag to be flown at any public or private site as being a representational symbol of Weakley County.
