

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-16

TO ADOPT THE PROVISIONS OF THE INMATE REIMBURSEMENT TO THE COUNTY ACT OF 1995

WHEREAS, the Inmate Reimbursement to the County Act of 1995, Chapter 522 of the Public Acts of 1995, codified in Tennessee Code Annotated 41-11-101 et seq. (the "Act"), is a local option law which authorizes counties to seek reimbursement from inmates in the county jail for any expenses incurred by the county up to sixty dollars (\$60.00) per day for maintaining the inmate, for the entire time the inmate is confined in the county jail, including pretrial detention; and

WHEREAS, then Weakley County Legislative Body has determined that it is in the best interests of Weakley County that the county adopt the Act and seek reimbursement from inmates under its provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of March, 1996 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated 41-11-112 (a), the provisions of the Inmate Reimbursement to the County Act of 1995 are hereby adopted for use in Weakley County to seek reimbursement from inmates in the county jail.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the, Board of County Commissioners.




