

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-39
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT
ON WEAKLEY COUNTY NURSING HOME ROAD

WHEREAS, a need is present for a reduction of speed on the Weakley County Nursing Home Road near Dresden, Tn. along the entire length of property line at the Nursing Home

WHEREAS, this reduction of speed could save lives of residents of the Nursing Home because they have wandered onto roadway at various times in the past.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of Highway Commissioners recommends that the speed limit be set by the Weakley County Legislative Body at 30 MPH for a distance of 1850 feet from property line to property line of the Nursing Home.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of January, 1997 that;

1. The speed limit along the entire property line of Weakley County Nursing Home be reduced to 30 MPH from this day forward
2. This resolution be spread upon the minutes of the County Commission.
