

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-60

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENN
SOLID WASTE FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997.**

WHEREAS, other appropriate equipment may be purchased for the Waste Convenience Center; and

WHEREAS, new equipment purchases for the Waste Convenience Center are subject to an 80% reimbursement from the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation Convenience Center Grant.
