

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-61

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENN
GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997.**

WHEREAS, corrective adjustments are necessary to a county employee line item; and

WHEREAS, no local tax dollars are involved in this instance as these funds are flow through funds from the Nutrition Program of the Northwest Tennessee Development District; and

WHEREAS, flow through funds by contract from Northwest Tennessee Development District Aging Program have increased funds for a computer.


