

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-62

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997.

WHEREAS, certain events have occurred requiring adjustments in the 1996-97 FY budget in the Weakley County Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing Accident resulting in a fatality on October 17, 1995 at McClain Road, crossing number 299 137 X, south of Martin, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, per T.C.A. 65-11-113, this crossing qualified for the installation of automatic flashing signal lights, bell; and also a constant warning track circuitry was needed.

WHEREAS, the cost of installing these devices shall be borne equally by the Norfolk Southern Railroad Company, the State of Tennessee and Weakley County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of March, 1997 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County, Highway Fund is hereby amended as follows:


