NOTE OF EXPLANATION:

Expenditures that we would be using the new 71600-320 LPN line item for include: the National Association of Practical Nurse Education & Services, Inc. application for membership & dues for Gwen Scarborough, Director of Nursing; Betty Lemonds, Practical Nursing Instructor; Natalie Scates, Practical Nursing Instructor. Memberships for our staff in this association would be a benefit for the practical nursing program and would not be held by these women if they were not involved in the practical nursing education program. This professional association assists in the networking of Practical Nursing Educators, informs us of the current trends and policies in practical nursing and practical nursing education and helps to keep its membership abreast of the best and latest in seminars and continuing education pertinent to our field. First time membership application and dues are currently \$30 per person. Tennessee State Board of Nursing Registered Nurse Licensure Renewal would also be taken from this line item. Betty Lemond's license is due to be renewed in November of 1997. Gwen Scarborough's license is due for renewal in March of 1999 and Natalie Scate's license is due for renewal in May of 1999. Currently licensure renewal is \$50. None of these women can perform the duties of their positions without a current and active license as a registered nurse in the state of Tennessee.
