RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF T.C.A. § 12-3-1001(d)
RELATIVE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT PURCHASING
IN WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has passed legislation authorizing counties to purchase items from local vendors without competitive bidding when such vendors are willing to sell items at the same or a lower price than the price available under a contract or price agreement with the state department of general services, provided that the county legislative body by 2/3 vote approves the law for application in the county; and


WHEREAS, the county legislative body of Weakley County finds that it is in the best interests of the county that the county government make purchases from local vendors whenever possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by 2/3 vote of the county legislative body of Weakley County, meeting in regular session at Dresden, Tennessee, that the provisions of T.C.A. § 12-3-1001(d) are hereby approved for use in Weakley County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on January 21, 1998, and that a copy of this resolution shall be filed by the County Clerk with the Comptroller of the Treasury immediately upon its passage and approval.






