RESOLUTION RATIFYING SALE OF SURPLUS REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, certain real estate, formerly used by Dresden Junior High School, was no longer used for school purposes and was sold at public auction to the highest and best bidder, Marvin Alexander, and

WHEREAS, after a title examination, it was revealed that the title to the property is vested in the name of the Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, it would be right and proper for the Board of County Commissioners to ratify the sale previously made to Marvin Alexander,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners assembled in regular session on this the 16th day of March, 1998, that:

SECTION 1. The sale of surplus real estate, formerly a part of Dresden Junior High School, to Marvin Alexander be hereby ratified.




