

RESOLUTION 1999-48

A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A COUNTY ATTORNEY FOR
WEAKLEY COUNTY EFFECTIVE MARCH 15, 1999

WHEREAS, Chapter 559, Private Acts of 1951, as amended, provides that the County Attorney for Weakley County shall be elected by the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the office of County Attorney will become vacant on March 15, 1999 as a result of the resignation of the current County Attorney effective on that date; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners desires that there be no delay in filling the vacancy created by the resignation of the current County Attorney; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, meeting in regular session on the 15th of March, 1999, that:


SECTION 1. The law firm of Neese, Herron & Miller-Herron is elected to the office of County Attorney for Weakley County, Tennessee and shall serve in this position until its successor is elected and qualified as provided for in Chapter 559, Private Acts of 1951, as amended.

SECTION 2. Mr. William R. Neese, of the law firm of Neese, Herron & Miller-Herron, shall serve in the capacity of primary attorney assigned to attend all County Commission meetings and attend to other matters as outlined in the aforementioned Private Act and as provided in the Rules and Procedures of the Weakley County Commission, as amended.

SECTION 3. The term of office for the new County Attorney shall begin immediately upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.




