TO HAVE THE ELECTION COMMISSION BUILDING REPAIRED.

WHEREAS, in January of 1999 one column fell and remains on the ground impeding citizens desiring to enter or exit the building; and


WHEREAS, this has created and continues to be a hazard to the safety of employees and others having business in the building; and

WHEREAS, this greatly detracts from the appearance of the building.


