

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-13

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE
WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2000.**

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Sheriff's Department is in need of a computer equipment upgrade in order for the department to function more proficiently; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department is requesting ten workstations to be installed all of which will be connected to the network and the law enforcement software in the amount of \$11,021.00; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Jail is in need of prisoner clothing, bedding, etc., to be utilized for prisoners at the new Weakley County Detention Center and L. E. Complex; and

WHEREAS, the above prisoner items will be purchased from Bob Barker Co., Inc. at the cost \$14,921.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of September, 1999 in Dresden, Tennessee this resolution is hereby approved.

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:

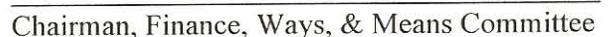

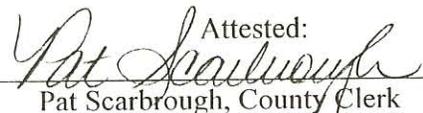

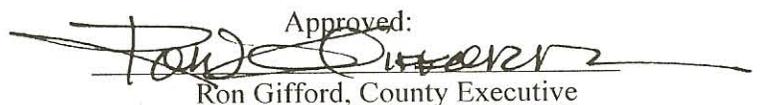
