

RESOLUTION CHANGING HOURS THAT VOTING POLLS REMAIN OPEN

WHEREAS, several factories and other places of business in Weakley County have requested that the voting polls remain open until 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Chamber of Commerce has requested that the voting = polls remain open until 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, to change the period the polls remain open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., to 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., will accomodate not only many businesses in the county, but also numerous employees; and

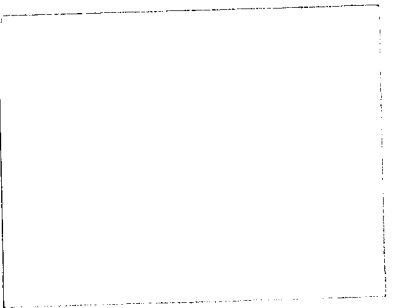
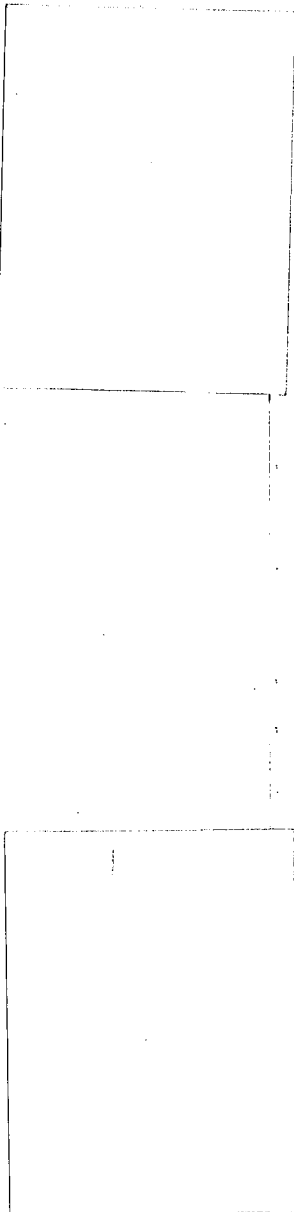
WHEREAS, it is felt that every possible concession should be made in the interest of lightening the trials and tribulations of voting by Weakley county citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Election Commission has determined, subject to the approval of the Weakley County Quarterly Court, that the voting hours should be changed as follows: that the polls open 10:00 a.m. rather than 9:00 a.m. ; and that they remain open until 6:00 P.M. rather than 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-1301, Tennessee Code Annotated provides that the Weakley County Election Commission may determine, with the approval of the Quarterly County Court, the hours when the polls shall be opened and closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court duly assembled in regular session this 13th day of July, 1970, that the said Weakley County Quarterly Court hereby approves the determination made by the Weakley County Election Commission that the voting polls beginning August 6, 1970, open at 10:00 a.m. and close at 6:00 p.m.

After a reading of said resolution it was moved by Buck Stow, seconded by Benie Bushart that said resolution be adopted by the Court and upon being put to a voice vote the same was unanimously adopted.
