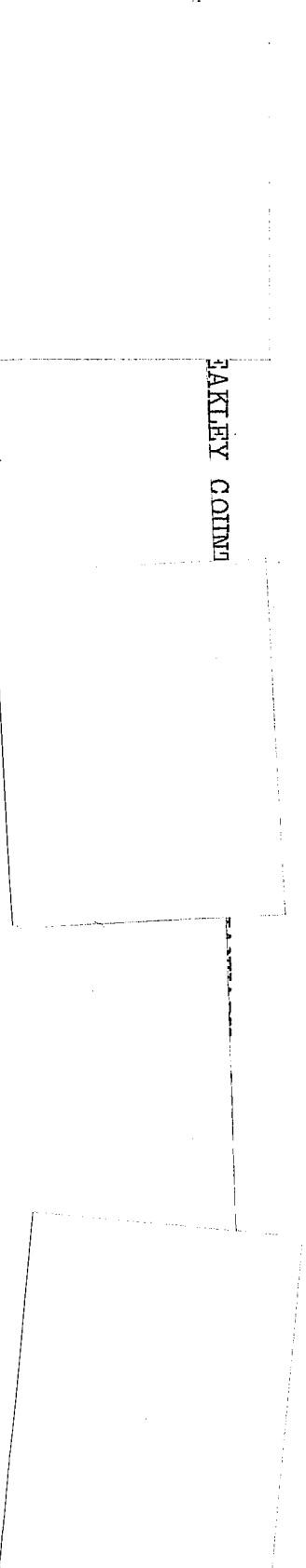

RESOLUTION - 1971-1

WHEREAS, certain estimates made at the formation and adoption of the Budget for 1970-71 must be amended in order to meet obligations that are now known, and

WHEREAS, after the County passed its General Fund Budget for fiscal year 1970-71 embracing State Department of Public Welfare programs, the State Department revised its original estimate of the County's proportionate share for supporting such programs and notified the County that its total budget for the welfare programs must be increased, and

WHEREAS, the County has no choice but to amend the budget accordingly, because State Law empowers the State Government to withhold State revenues from the County in the event the obligations are not paid,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court assembled in regular business session on the 11th day of January 1971 that it is our hope and urgent request that the State Government will do all in its power to urge the Federal Government to take over the welfare program altogether, because the limited resources of the State and Local Governments render it unfeasible for them to shoulder increased portion of the financial burden of the welfare grant programs.

Motion was made by Esq. W. H. Dudley and seconded by Esq. Clyde B. Miles that the above resolution be approved by the Court. Upon being put to a voice vote, same carried unanimously.
