R E S O L U T I O N - 1971 # 2

Whereas, It appears to the Court that the salary of the Weakley County Road Supervisor does not seem to be commensurate with the salaries of other county officials or with salaries of county road supervisors of other counties in this area.

And, Whereas, It appears to the Court that this might be an appropriate time to request our representatives in the 1971 General Assembly to pass legislation to correct this inequality.

Therefore, Be it resolved that the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session request our representatives in the 1971 General Assembly, Ned Ray McWhorter and Larry Bates and our Senator Milton Hamilton to enact an Amendment to the Weakley County Road Law changing the annual salary of the Road Supervisor from \$6,500.00 to 10,000.00.

Motion was made by Esq. Denton Bell and seconded by Esq. Joe C. Hunt that the above report be approved by the Court.

After further discussion:

Motion was made by Gerald Freeman and seconded Esq. Clyde B. Miles to amend the original resolution to substitute \$8,000.00 for \$10,000.00 per year, and to further amend the original resolution to establish the effective date of the resolution to be July 1, 1971. Amendment to the resolution was put to a voice vote and same carried unanimously.
