RESOLUTION # 1972-2

RESOLUTION OF THE WAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY COURT ESTABLISHING PERMANENT COMMITTEES OF THAT BODY.

WHEREAS, It appears that the standing committee system of this court does not include all areas warranting committee service and.

WHEREAS, it appears that expansion and reorganization of our standing committees would be advantageous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the standing committees of this Court shall be as follows:

1. Finance
2. Budget
3. Nursing Home
4. Health, Education, and Welfare
5. Governmental Relations
6. Agricultural and Industrial
7. Investment
8. Beer

SECTION 2. That, the Ambulance Authority is hereby retained as a functioning board controlling ambulance service operations until such time as this Court sees fit to reorganize operations in that area.

RESOLUTION # 1972 - 2 (CONTINUED)

SECTION 3. That, no Committe, Board or Authority shall comprise of less than three (3) nor more than seven (7) members, except that Budget Committee be composed of exactly five (5) members

SECTION 4. That, appointments to the above named committees and authority be approved January 10, 1972, at the regular term of this Court and subsequently appointments to such committess, authorities and/or boards will be made at the October term as prescribed by the duly adopted rules and regulations of this Court.

SECTION 5. That, all Committee, Board and/or Authority appointment's shall be filled in keeping with provisions of the rules governing the procedures of this body.

SECTION 6. That, all committees shall be subject to call by the respective Chairman and/or the county judge.

SECTION 7. That no member of this body shall serve concurrently on the Finance or Budget Committee.

SECTION 8. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and that provisions of this resolution shall become effective immediately following appointment of committemen in January 1972.
