Weakley County Quarterly Court, April 1972 Term

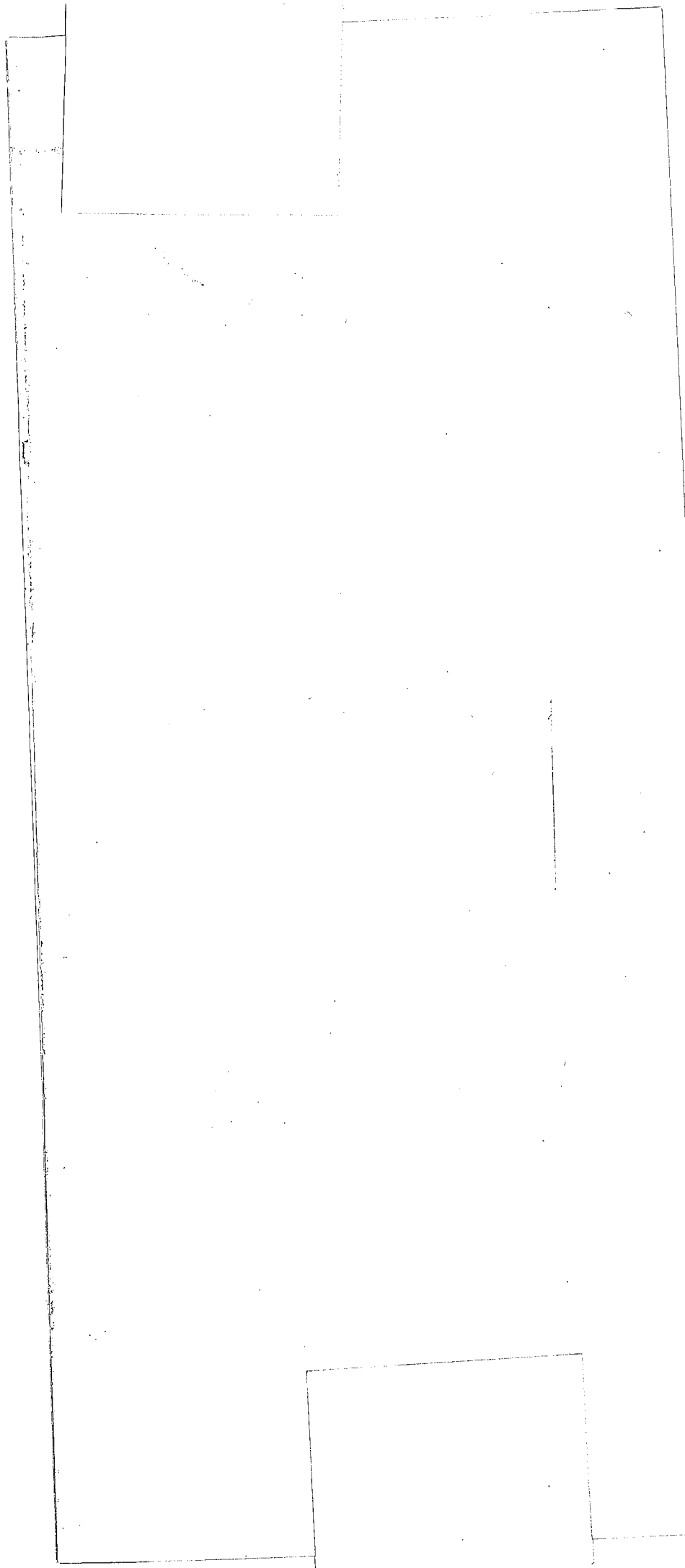
WHEREAS, at the time the 1971-72 Budget was adopted, the total amount of the expenses of elections could not be ascertained, and

WHEREAS, since that time it has been determined that this county would be required to hold a Presidential Preference Primary, and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient funds in the item, Election Expense, to hold this election.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court at its April 1972 Term that the General Fund Budget Item, Election Expense, be amended from Un-appropriated General Fund Balance of \$46,782.00 in the following manner:
