beginning on Ruthville road, (at Mr. Moriah road), running east a distance of approximately .3 miles, thence south a distance of approximately .2 miles.

The aforesaid road does not touch the lands of any person other than the undersigned and no other person uses the same and the closure of such road could not affect the right of interest or interests of any other person.

The aforesaid road is no longer used as a public road and has not been considered by the County Highway Department as a public road for sometime.

PETITIONERS PRAY that the County Highway Commission take favorable action on this petition at its next meeting, to the end that the matter may be submitted to the County Quarterly Court at its meeting on the second Monday in April, 1972.

RESOLUTION 1972-9

The Tennessee State Statute provides that Counties must institute suits to collect delinquent taxes and have a tax sale within 3 years after the taxes are due, or the taxes will be barred from collection. This statute has been in force for two years.

The Weakley County Quarterly Court being aware of this new law, authorized the County Attorney to proceed with instituting writs to collect delinquent taxes, and have a tax sale this year (1972).

Motion was made by Esq. Joe C. Hunt and seconded by Esq. Junius White that the foregoing resolution be adopted by the Court. Upon being put to a voice votes, same carried unanimously.
