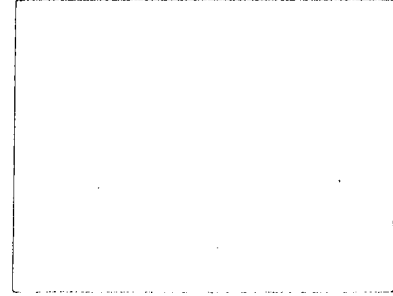
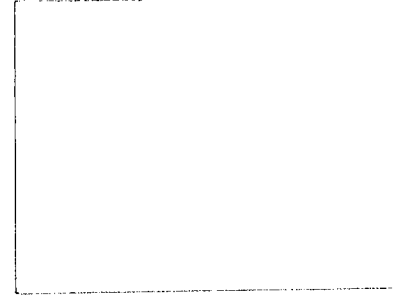


ELECTION EXPENSE



RESOLUTION NO. 1974-10:

WHEREAS, when the 1973-74 General Fund Budget was adopted the exact amounts needed in each item of the budget could not be fully anticipated, and

WHEREAS, it appears at this time that certain budget items will be short of the amount needed

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Weakley County Quarterly Court, meeting in regular session April 8, 1974, amends the following items of the 1973-74 budget from anticipated Unappropriated General Fund Balance:

AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 1973-22

WHEREAS the Weakley County Rural Road Maintenance Committee met and after hearing complaints that resulted from the Rural Road Maintenance Plan which was put into effect during the October Term of Weakley County Quarterly Court, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the Committee felt that additional criteria was needed in the original resolution to provide a better Rural Road Maintenance Plan. The Committee recommended the following amendment to Resolution No. 1973-22:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, that Resolution No. 1973-22 (Rural Road Maintenance Plan) be amended to include as follows: Those roads appearing on the 1970 State Rural Road Map which have been maintained during the calendar years of 1972-73 and continue to maintain these roads to the nearest access of each separate farm.

Esq. R. H. Pearson moved that the foregoing Amendment be adopted by the court, and Esq. George Hearn seconded the motion.


