

TO RESCIND SPECIAL CALLED SESSION ACTION ON RRSP

Upon being put to a roll call vote: Aye 17, Nay 3, Absent 1.
The foregoing Rule Suspension motion carried.

Original motion was put to a roll call vote: Aye 12, Nay 8, Absent 1.

RURAL ROAD PLAN AMENDMENT

Esq. R. H. Pearson moved for the Quarterly Court to amend the Rural Road Plan by accepting those roads appearing on the 1970 State Rural Road Map which have been maintained during the calendar years of 1972-73 and continue to maintain these roads to the nearest access of each separate farm. The motion was seconded by Esq. Johnny Tharp.

Esq. R. H. Pearson moved to suspend the rule to allow action on the above motion. Motion was seconded by Esq. George Hearn.

Upon being put to a roll call vote for suspension of the rule:
Aye 11, Nay 9, Absent 1. The foregoing motion to suspend the rule failed the two-thirds majority; therefore no action was taken on the original motion.


