RESOLUTION OF THE QUARTERLY COUNTY COURT OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, TO REQUIRE CERTAIN REPORTS FROM CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICIALS.

WHEREAS, Many questions have been raised as to the amount of officer's cost being turned over to the County and the amount paid to non-salaried officers; and,

WHEREAS, this body is not receiving any report from the Sheriff or the Clerks of Court as to the amount of this cost collected and paid; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and his Deputies are paid a salary and expenses from the County General Fund which is funded by property tax monies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Sheriff file a report with the County Judge monthly stating by Sheriff and Deputy a listing of persons arrested, number in jail at the end of the month, number working, number of papers served, and total number of miles driven.

SECTION 2. That the Circuit and General Sessions Court Clerk, Clerk and Master and County Court Clerk file with the County Judge monthly a listing name and amount of money turned over to the County from their respective courts for the Sheriff and each Deputy and the amount paid to each constable or any other non-salaried officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Sheriff, Circuit Court Clerk, Clerk and Master, and County Court Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all papers, whether civil or criminal be executed, in as far as possible, by the salaried officers employed by Weakley County, Tennessee.
