

RESOLUTION NO. 1976-39:

RESOLUTION TO AMEND
ANTICIPATED FUND AVAILABILITY
AND APPROPRIATIONS OF THE
WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
FOR FISCAL 1975-76

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain adjustments to anticipated fund availability and appropriations are needed in certain areas of the 1975-76 budget controlling operations of the County Highway Department and,

WHEREAS, additional appropriations are needed in given areas and in other appropriations are in excess; and

WHEREAS, it appears that unneeded appropriations in given instances will be adequate to finance much needed increased appropriations.
