

RESOLUTION NO. 1976-46:RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN
WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1976.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this 12th day of July, 1976, that the combined property tax rate for Weakley County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976, shall be \$3.37 on each \$100.00 of taxable property, which is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:

<u>FUND</u>	<u>RATE</u>
County General	\$.20
Highway	.90
General Purpose School	1.47
Debt Service	.80
Total	<u>\$3.37</u>

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby levied a gross receipts tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the gross receipts tax herein levied shall accrue to the County General Fund.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Quarterly County Court.
