

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH CONSTABLE DISTRICTS FOR THE
ELECTION OF CONSTABLES IN WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 8-1001 mandates that the county legislative body establish constable districts of substantially equal population from which constables are to be elected; and WHEREAS, the same statute provides that the number of constables elected in a county shall not exceed one-half (1/2) the number of county commissioners elected in the county.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission of Weakley County, meeting on this 21st day of January 1980, that for the purposes herein stated, Weakley County shall have ten (10) constable districts for the purpose of electing county constables. The boundaries of each constable district shall be the same as each of the ten zones established for the election of county commissioners. One (1) constable shall be elected from each zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective on the date of adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
