

A Resolution Condemning the Hunting of Deer in Weakley County with Rifles.

WHEREAS, the hunting of deer in Weakley County has been permitted by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency for approximately ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency has honored a resolution, adopted by the Weakley County Legislative Body on October 12, 1970, condemning the hunting of deer in Weakley County with rifles, by issuing a proclamation prohibiting the hunting of deer in Weakley County with rifles; and

WHEREAS, The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency conducted a public hearing in the Weakley County courthouse on March 11, 1980, to determine if the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency should allow the hunting of deer in Weakley County with rifles; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was attended by approximately three hundred (300) interested property owners and sportsmen. A show of hands indicated the majority of those present wanted the hunting of deer in Weakley County to remain as it is: rifles not permitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body at its regular meeting this the 21st day of April, 1980, by the adoption of this resolution, condemns the hunting of deer in Weakley County with rifles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body that it does favor and strongly requests the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency continue the current regulation prohibiting deer hunting in Weakley County with rifles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be certified by the County Clerk and forwarded to the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency for its information and consideration and copies be sent to the elected members of the Tennessee General Assembly representing ~~Weakley~~ Counties of the Weakley County Legislative Body, this Resolution is sponsored by the following Commissioners:
