

RESOLUTION #1980-14

A Resolution to Amend the Existing Motor Ambulance Service Contract Between the Weakley County Legislative Body and Emergency Ambulance.

WHEREAS, Weakley County now receives motor ambulance service through a contract with Emergency Ambulance Service; and

WHEREAS, the existing contract was entered into on March 18, 1977, and expires at the July regular meeting of the Weakley County Legislative Body 1980; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 1978-17 adopted by Weakley County Legislative Body on July 19, 1978, amended the original contract by changing the expiration date to read 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Ambulance Committee representing the Weakley County Legislative Body has met with Mr. Paul Hathcoat, dba Emergency Ambulance Service, and has been informed that new equipment must be purchased and that Mr. Hathcoat is encountering problems getting financial assistance from financial lending institutions due to short time remaining on the existing contract; and

WHEREAS, the Ambulance Committee of the Weakley County Legislative Body recommends the adoption of this Resolution to amend the existing contract, as amended, by extending the expiration date to July 1985 regular meeting of the Weakley County Legislative Body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body in a regular meeting, this the 21st day of April, 1980, that the above recommendation be adopted by changing the year 1981 to read 1985 in Paragraph 13 of the Original Contract, dated 16th day of February, 1977, between Weakley County Legislative Body and the Emergency Ambulance Service.
