

RESOLUTION 1980-15

A Resolution to Commit County Funds for One-Half of 20% Matching Funds for an Off-System Bridge to be Built Joint with Carroll County.

WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation has completed the Off-System Bridge Inspection, required under the 1978 Surface Transportation Act, of off-system bridges that would qualify for federal funds, and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has submitted as its first choice, for replacement under this program, a bridge joint-owned with Carroll County, Tennessee, and

WHEREAS, This joint-owned/qualifies for early implementation under this program, one to three years, depending on available federal funds.

WHEREAS, this Bridge Program will be financed with 80% federal funds and 20% local funds; preliminary cost estimate, at current construction cost, is \$221,450.00 which means Weakley County and Carroll County would share equal matching funds of \$44,290.00, and

WHEREAS, The Tennessee Department of Transportation requires a commitment on 20% matching funds as computed on final cost from Weakley and Carroll Counties no later than May 1, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body in a regular meeting, this the 21st day of April, 1980, that, by the adoption of this resolution, commits Weakley County for one-half of the 20% matching funds required under the 1978 Surface Transportation Act for a qualifying off-system bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, if adopted, will become null and void if Carroll County, Tennessee, fails to commit, by proper resolution, itself for the remaining one-half of the 20% matching funds as required.
