

RESOLUTION NO. 1987-53

RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE CITY OF GLEASON
PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION TO CITIZENS OUTSIDE
THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GLEASON
ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-54-601(c) provides that:

"c) Any incorporated city or town may provide fire protection to citizens outside the territorial limits of the municipality on an individual contractual basis whenever an agreement has been made for the extension of that service by the legislative body of the municipality and the legislative body of the county in which the fire protection is to be provided.", and

WHEREAS, the City of Gleason, Tennessee, provides such fire protection outside its territorial limits on an individual contractual basis, and desires to continue to provide such service, and


WHEREAS, in order to be in compliance with Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-54-601(c), the City of Gleason has requested that the legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, give its consent to the continuation of such fire protection service by the City of Gleason, and


WHEREAS, the legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, does not provide fire protection services to the citizens of Weakley County and believes it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Weakley County for the City of Gleason to continue to provide such services outside its territorial limits according to its policies and procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on the 19th day of October, 1987, that until further notice, it is agreed, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-54-601(c), that the City of Gleason, Tennessee, may continue to provide fire protection to citizens of Weakley County, Tennessee, outside the territorial limits of the City of Gleason, on an individual basis according to the policies and procedures of the City of Gleason.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.


