

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-30

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SUBDIVISION ADDITION TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT MAINTENANCE SYSTEM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 17, 1989.

WHEREAS, subdivision is known as PLANTATION ESTATES and is herein described below:

Beginning with north margin of Hawks Road; thence north 800 feet with Wheat Street to Sugar Lane; thence west approx. 1,000 feet to Tobacco Drive; thence south 900 feet to the north margin of Hawks Road. Cotton Boll Circle runs west from Wheat Street for a distance of 320 feet to a cul de sac.

WHEREAS, this subdivision does hereby meet all of the requirements of the standard specifications for addition of subdivisions to be added to the county maintenance system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Weakley County Commission at the regular July 17, 1989 meeting, the within named PLANTATION ESTATES subdivision is hereby approved for the addition to the Weakley County Rural Road Maintenance System.
