

RESOLUTION NO. 1990 - 21

RESOLUTION FOR ADDITION OF OLD PILLOWVILLE ROAD TO THE
COUNTY MAINTENANCE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the county legislative body has the duty to designate the public roads of the county, to be maintained by the county, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Road Board has recommended the addition of OLD PILLOWVILLE ROAD, east of Greenfield, to the county road list, said road being located in the County Commission District 3 and beginning at Highway #190 on first road that turns east and west from Highway 54 behind what has been known as Martin Store. West of Highway 190 the distance of the road is 792 feet and thence crossing Highway 190 the distance east is approximately 264 feet. The width of said road is 20 feet with the right of way being 30 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body in regular session at Dresden, Tennessee, on this the 16th day of April, 1990 that:

SECTION 1: Old Pillowville Road is hereby designated a county road and formally added to the list of county roads to be maintained by the Chief Administrative Officer of the County Highway Department of Weakley County.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
