RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ROAD CLOSURE
FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 1993

WHEREAS, road runs east from I.C. Railroad approximately .3 mile to Sand Hill Rd. in Martin. This is an abandoned road that runs between Thompson Farm and the Myrick Farm. The right-of-way will be reverted back to the ownership by the property owners listed on the application attached, with the east-west property line centered in the middle of the road right-of-way

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Road Board recommends the above road closure to the Weakley County Rural Road System of Maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Weakley County Commission at the regular October 19, 1992 meeting, that the road described above be approved for closure and be deleted as an official county road.
