

A RESOLUTION MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO NON-PROFIT  
CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
BEGINNING JULY 1, 1994 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1995

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-9-109 allows the County Legislative Body of Weakley County to appropriate funds for the financial aid of any non-profit charitable organization; and

WHEREAS, the 1994-95 FY operating budget contains appropriations for the financial aid of non-profit charitable organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County on this the 18th day of July, 1994.

1. That Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500) be appropriated for the Weakley County Rescue Squad to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
2. That Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500) be appropriated for the Speech and Hearing Center to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
3. That Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) be appropriated for the Jackson Council on Alcoholism (JACO) to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
4. That Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) be appropriated for the Community Development Services to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
5. That Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) be appropriated for the Northwest Counseling Center to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
6. That Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Five dollars (18,285) be appropriated for the Obion-Forked Deer River Basin Authority to benefit the welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
7. That Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000) be appropriated for the Weakley County Chamber of Commerce to benefit the welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
8. That Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) be appropriated for Tourism to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
9. That Twenty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Six (\$26,806) be appropriated for Weakley County Library to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
10. That Three Thousand Five Hundred Seventeen Dollars (3517) be appropriated for Northwest Tennessee Development District to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
11. That One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) Dollars be appropriated for U.T.M. Infant Stimulation Program to benefit the welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
12. That Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) be appropriated for TAMB of Jackson (Aspell Manor) to benefit the welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
13. That Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) be appropriated for Tennessee Division of Forestry to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
14. That Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$2,167) be appropriated for the Crippled Children Services for the Tennessee Department of Health to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
15. That Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) be appropriated for each of the following fire departments: Como/Ore Springs, Palmersville and Sidonia to benefit the welfare of the residents of Weakley County.
16. That One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) be appropriated for Disabled Veterans to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all appropriations enumerated One (1) through Sixteen (16) above are made subject to the following conditions:

1. That the non-profit charitable organizations to which funds are appropriated shall file with the County Clerk and the disbursing officials a copy of an annual report of its business affairs and transactions and the proposed use of the county's funds in accordance with rules promulgated by the Comptroller of the Treasury, Chapter 0380-2-7. Such annual report shall be prepared and certified by the chief financial officer of such non-profit organization in accordance with Section 5-932(c), T.C.A.
2. That said funds must only be used by the named non-profit charitable organizations in furtherance of their non-profit charitable purposes benefiting the general welfare of the residents of the county.
3. That it is the expressed interest of the County Commission of Weakley County in providing these funds to the above named non-profit charitable organizations to be fully in compliance with Chapter 0390-2-7 of the Rules of the Comptroller of the Treasury, and Section 5-932 of Tennessee Code Annotated and any and all other laws which may apply to county appropriations to non-profit organizations and so this appropriation is made subject to compliance with any and all of these laws and regularions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and its provisions shall be in force from and after July 1, 1994.

This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
