**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2014.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Tennessee Department of Health has awarded special needs funding to Weakley County, this is the first of three yearly payments; and

**WHEREAS**, Weakley County received \$28,418 as Tobacco Settlement funds; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used in conducting tobacco settlement projects for Weakley County students such as the teens against tobacco use project.

**SECTION 1.** The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:


