

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A RULES COMMITTEE OF
THE WEAKLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners has such a committee in place, and the need may arise to amend said rules and with the need to appoint committees of the Weakley County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, members of the County Commission will be elected in the August 7, 2014, general election; and

WHEREAS, new officials, as well as incumbent officials and the general public, need to be knowledgeable of the rules, procedures and committees of the county legislative body.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on this 28th day of July, 2014, that:

SECTION 1. Nine (9) County Commissioners be appointed to serve on a committee to study and recommend the rules, procedures, and committee structure of the county legislative body, to make recommendations for committee assignments and to make nominations to fill offices as required by law to be filled by the County Legislative Body.

SECTION 2. The committee members appointed shall be as follows:

District 1 John Salmon	District 4 William T. Jones	District 7 David Hawks
District 2 Eric Owen	District 5 Larry W. Taylor	District 8 Sam Sinclair
District 3 Mike Medling	District 6 Earl Wright	District 9 James H. Westbrook, Jr.

In the event John Salmon is not reelected in District 1, James F. Bynum is appointed. In the event William T. Jones is not re-elected in District 4, Joe W. Farmer is appointed. In the event Sam Sinclair is not re-elected in District 8, Jack Vincent is appointed. In the event Mike Medling is not re-elected in District 3 or David Hawks is not re-elected in District 7, the persons receiving the most votes, in their respective districts, in the general election are appointed as members of the Rules Committee.

SECTION 3. The first meeting of the committee will be immediately following the 9:00 a.m. swearing-in ceremony to be held in the Weakley County Commission Courtroom on Monday, September 1, 2014.

SECTION 4. The committee shall report their recommendations to the county legislative body at the first meeting, whether regular or called, held on or after September 1, 2014. The committee report shall be the first item of business considered at such meeting and in case of a called meeting the committee report shall be included in the call.

SECTION 5. For organizational purposes and until new rules are adopted, the Weakley County Board of Commissioners will operate under the rules approved September 12, 2013 as amended.

SECTION 6. All resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
