**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REPEAL
CHAPTER 175, PRIVATE ACTS OF 1978**

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee passed and the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County approved by two-thirds vote an act to tax each criminal suit filed in the courts of the County two dollars (\$2.00) to provide funds for the purpose of financing a law library and providing funds for improvement of the jail, courthouse grounds and facilities; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County no longer maintains a County Governmental Library.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Legislative Body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session in Dresden, Tennessee, on this 19th day of September 2016, that the General Assembly be asked to repeal Chapter 175 of the Private Acts of 1978, as amended by Chapter 50 of the Private Acts of 1997.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution sponsored by two-thirds of the members of the County Legislative Body be sent to members of the 110th General Assembly representing Weakley County, Tennessee.






